

**Minutes of the meeting held on 10th May 2018
in Lamorna Village Hall at 7.31pm**

1.	Present	Councillors M Sagar-Fenton (Chairman), J Jeffery, A Giles and A Sunderland. Also present was Mrs Alexis Male (clerk).
2.	Apologies	No apologies were necessary.
3.	Declarations of Interest	There were no declarations of interest.
4.	Minutes	The minutes of the meeting held on 5 th March 2018, were read and agreed to be a true and correct record.
5.	Public Speaking	No members of the public were present.
6.	Co-Option	No further suggestions were forthcoming.
7.	Finance	<p>The clerk reported a current account balance of 1200.22, payments totalling £15.00 having been agreed.</p> <p>The Income and Expenditure account for the year ended 31st March 2018 was agreed.</p> <p>The annual invitation to subscribe to Cornwall Association of Local Councils had been received. The cost for the year would be £119.89. It was agreed to accept.</p> <p>No requests for donations had been received during the year.</p>
8.	Planning	<p>No planning applications had been received.</p> <p>No further decisions had been received.</p>
9.	Footpaths and Highways	<p>No matters had been reported to the Parish Council.</p> <p>It was confirmed that the contractor had accepted the additional work of cutting the South West Coastal Path.</p>
10.	Correspondence & Reports from Councillors	<p>Police Liaison Group, Tuesday 24th April 2018 – Unfortunately, Councillor Mike Sagar-Fenton had not received the notification about this meeting. The clerk informed members that there had been presentations from PC James Perkins about defibrillators, Bob Henderson on licensing, the most important update from which was that Temporary Event Notices now only required forty eight hours’ notice, PCSO Jeremy Kewn on Community Speedwatch and Mary Shead on Neighbourhood Watch. The clerk was able to confirm that emails from Neighbourhood Watch would be sent to her and she would forward relevant alerts on to the councillors.</p>

		<p>West Penwith Community Network Panel, Thursday 17th May 2018 – The Chairman would try to attend.</p> <p>West Penwith Town and Parish Clerks and Chairs Meeting, Tuesday 1st May 2018 – The clerk reported that discussions had focused on two topics. The first was about the formation of a Community Interest Company to address the needs for providing transport to and from hospital. The second matter was the new Highways Scheme which would provide £50000 per annum to the Community Network Area for the next four years. This money was not for maintenance or safety issues and one expression of interest in a scheme could be submitted per Town or Parish Council and one per Divisional Member.</p>
11.	Items for next meeting's agenda	<p>The matters of the new General Data Protection Regulations and the Draft Recommendations on Divisional Boundaries in Cornwall would need to be on the next agenda.</p> <p>There being no further business, the meeting closed at 8.11pm.</p>
